#### Feeding recommendations

Milking cows - up to 5 (typically 3)kg mixed with other feeds  
 Dry cows - up to 2 (typically 1)kg  
 Replacement Heifers - up to 2kg and up to 30% of DMI  
 Calves - up to 1.5kg and up to 25% of DMI (Dry matter intake)  
 Growing cattle - up to 3kg and up to 40% of DMI  
 Finishing Cattle - up to 5kg and up to 50% of DMI  
 Suckler cows - up to 3 (typically 1)kg  
 Ewes and Rams - up to 1 (typically 0.5)kg  
 Hoggets and Lambs - up to 0.75 per head or up to 40% of DMI  
 Ensure adequate long fibre such as silage or straw. Introduce gradually. Do not feed ad lib. Store in a cool dry place
